About the Institution

The **Institute of Evolutionary Biology (IBE)** is a joint center of the **Spanish National Research Council (CSIC)** and **Pompeu Fabra University (UPF)**. IBE's research focuses on the processes and mechanisms that generate biodiversity,

covering topics such as genetic and molecular evolution, population biology, complex systems biology, and the recovery of ancient DNA.

IBE is the only research center in Catalonia and Spain dedicated entirely to evolutionary biology and is a reference in this field in Southern Europe. Around 130 people work at the IBE, distributed between its two neighboring facilities at the <u>Barcelona Biomedical Research Park (PRBB)</u> and the <u>Mediterranean Center for</u> <u>Marine and Environmental Research (CMIMA)</u>.

The Institute Research projects/grants management unit is in charge of planning & coordination of research grant applications, as well as grants management: compliace & regulatory oversight, administrative support to researchers, scientific & economic reporting, etc.

Responsibilities

- Active search and dissemination of new international funding opportunities aligned with the institute's research lines.
- Supporting researchers in understanding the regulations and requirements of competitive funding calls.
- Individualized support to research groups in preparing proposals for international funding programs (project description, budget, documentation, etc.).
- Preparing and monitoring consortium and grant agreements.
- Institutional communication with international partners and other relevant stakeholders.
- Participation in coordination and follow-up meetings for international projects.
- Monitoring management indicators for the Internationalization Office.
